Terms and conditions

Registration

L. All entries in the registration form must be completed for it to be valid.

Fees

- 2. Each weekly lesson is 2 hours long.
- 3. Course fees stated overleaf are net. There are no additional charges for printing of course materials and no initial deposits.
- 4. Course fees are to be paid monthly in full sum as stated, with exception for the first month, where fees will be prorated based on number of lessons (out of 4) expected to take place.
- 5. Course fees are for group tuition calculated based on 4 lessons per month. However, in the event that there are 5 scheduled lessons within the month, course fees still remain at the stipulated price as a complimentary lesson.

Payment modes

- 6. Payment can be made by cash, cheque or ibanking.
- 7. Envelops will be provided for students to seal their payments and pass to their tutors. The student's full name, amount payable and payment period are to be written clearly on the envelop.
- 8. Payment via ibanking should be transferred to OCBC current account '519-165583-001'. The student's full name should be mentioned in the transfer comment.
- 9. Cheques should be crossed and made payable to 'Orion Tuition Centre LLP'. Please write the student's full name and registered handphone number on the reverse side of the cheque. Postdated cheques are not accepted and we are not liable for any bank charges incurred.
- 10. Any returned cheque due to the drawer's fault will incur an administration fee of \$10.

Missed lessons

- 11. For students attending private (one-to-one) lessons, cancellation of lessons less than 24 hours before the lesson will incur an administration fee of \$30.
- 12. No lessons are conducted on public holidays, Chinese New Year's Eve and the period 28 December 2017 3 Jan 2018.
- 13. If students miss a scheduled weekly lesson with valid Medical Certificate (MC), they are to contact their respective tutors for alternative arrangements, which may either be a refund or a make-up lesson, up to the tutor's discretion. For absentees without any MCs, there will be strictly no refunds or make-up lessons arranged.
- 14. A maximum of one (1) missed lesson per term is eligible for alternative arrangements described in Point (13). Beyond which, there will be no refunds and make-up lessons allowed and the full fees will apply.

Others

- 15. Refreshments are provided free for all students. OTC seeks the co-operation of all users to help maintain the cleanliness of the Centre.
